Why are honeybees sometimes called "White man's flies?." North American natives call honeybees this because they were brought to North America by European colonists.

Name 3 task of the worker bee. Cleaning hive, nursing or feeding larva, caring for the queen, guarding hive, cooling the hive, producing beeswax, collecting pollen and nectar.

Name 2 fruits or vegetables that are heavily pollinated by honeybees. Apples, blueberries, cherries, watermelon, cantaloupe, plums, squash, cucumbers or almonds.



How many flowers does a honey bee visit during one collecting trip? 50-100.

How do honeybees communicate with one another? "Dancing." Honeybees do a dance which alerts other bees where nectar and pollen was located. The dance explains the direction and distance. Bees also communicate with pheromones.

How far does a hive of bees fly to bring you one pound of honey? Over 55,000 miles.

How much honey does the average worker honeybee make in her lifetime? 1/12 teaspoon.

How fast does a honeybee fly? About 15 miles per hour.

How many beekeepers are there in the United States? Over 200,000 beekeepers.

How many states have crops pollinated by honeybees? All 50

On average, how many bees are there in one beehive? Between 60,000 and 80,000.

How much honey would it take to fuel a bee's flight around the world? About one ounce.

How many flowers must bees tap to make one pound of Honey? Two Million
